Equipment at Level 2 pharmacies and NRN Harm Reduction Service

- 1ml and 2ml barrels (Low Dead Space)
- Range of pins (needles) for all injection sites
- 1ml fixed syringes (pin and barrel in one)
- Prep spoons
- Pre-injection swabs
- Sharps bins
- Citric and Vit C acidifiers
- Foil
- Sterile water for injection (plastic 5ml amps)

At the level 2 pharmacies and NRN Harm Reduction Service, you can take as many items as you need in any combination.

You should always try to take a sharps bin and try to bring back your returns!

Level 1 packs

Red - 5 sets of kit for injecting into veins (heroin)

Blue - 5 sets of kits for injecting into deeper veins (heroin) with long blue needle

Purple - 5 sets of kit for injecting into deeper veins (heroin) with long orange needle

Green - 10 sets of kit for injecting amphetamine (2ml barrels)

Orange - 10 sets of kit for injecting intramuscular steroids

Yellow - 10 sets of kit for injecting subcutaneously (under the skin)
