Earache (children aged 1-17)

Sore throat (over 5s)



Impetigo (over 1s)





## Think Pharmacy First!

If your child is off sick with any of these conditions, go straight to your local pharmacy for a consultation with the pharmacist and receive advice and medication if required.

You do not need a GP appointment.

## **Pharmacy First Services in Nottinghamshire**



Most pharmacies can help you with the following conditions without needing a GP appointment. When you request an appointment at your practice, if you can be treated by a pharmacist, you will be supported to make an appointment at your local pharmacy rather than at the GP practice.



Sinusitis (adults & children aged 12 years and over)

Sore throat (adults & children aged 5 years and over)

Earache (children & young adults aged 1 year to 17 years)

Infected insect bites (adults & children aged 1 year and over)

Impetigo (adults & children aged 1 year and over)

**Shingles** (adults aged 18 and over)

Urinary tract infection (UTI) (women aged 16 to 64 years)
